

Proposal to expand and extend the age range of Scott Lower School, Bedford

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 as amended by the Education Act 2011 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alternations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that Bedford Borough Council intends to make prescribed alterations to Scott Lower School, Hawk Drive Bedford with effect from 1 September 2017.

The Proposal

The proposal is to change the age range of the school from 4 - 9 years to 4 - 11 years and expand the school. The capacity of the school will increase to 630

Related Proposal

The prescribed alterations are related to the proposal to discontinue Beauchamp Middle School.
