COMPUTING

We will continue to learn about e-safety and our topic is 'We are researchers'. We will be exploring how a range of search engines work and how to refine their searches. The children will learn how to present their findings using a range of programs such as Microsoft Word, Powerpoint and 2Simple.

We will study a range of fiction and non-fiction texts to inspire our writing. We will continue to focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar.
