Step by Step guide to using MyMaths

MyMaths is an online maths resource which we will be using at Scott Primary for supporting the learning that is happening in the classroom in Key Stage 2 (Years 3 – 6).

Teachers will set maths homework every week. On alternate weeks, this homework will be through the MyMaths website.

Each individual child will have their own page which they will be able to access, and teachers will ensure that any task set will be of an appropriate level to reinforce the learning from that week.

To access your child's MyMaths account

- 1) Type in website address www.mymaths.co.uk
- 2) To access the Scott page on the MyMaths site, type

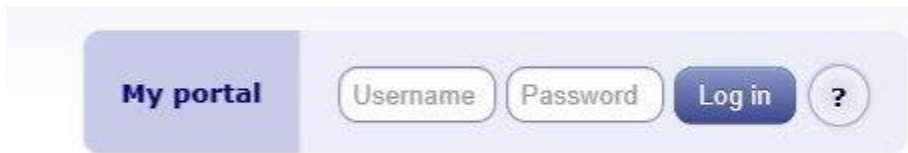
scott1 in the login box
circle12 in the password box

Then click on Log in

- 3) All children will be issued with a Username (3digits) and password (3 letters).

These can be inserted in the login spaces next to the My Portal button (top right of screen).

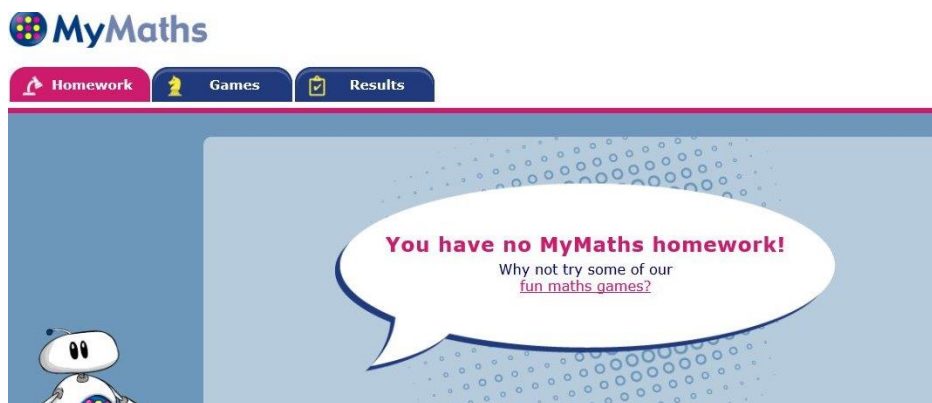


4) You will now see this screen:



The homework tab is open, and any homework your child has been set will appear, with a due date. They can just click on the task to start.

5) If they have no homework, the screen will direct them to a number of maths games that can be played on the MyMaths website.




Games can be selected at any time, by clicking the Games tab. We recommend completing the homework first though!!


6) By clicking the activity, it will invite you to Start Homework.
