SUPERHERO COSTUMES



In Science we will be learning about the uses of everyday materials and which materials would be most suitable for the superheroes' needs.

DATES FOR YOUR DIARY

-Pupils must have their own named water bottle in class.

This does not need to be returned to school. A comment in the reading record can be made to show the task has been completed.

They will also be given an additional piece of mathematics homework on a Friday.

This will need to be returned to school by the following Friday, allowing the children a week to complete the activity.

Please continue to read with your child at home, and write / sign in their reading record to show that they have finished a book or a bug club book.

HOMEWORK

-Continue to read frequently with your child using their bookmark when discussing the text.

-Please support your child to learn weekly spellings or dictation and write sentences including these words.

-It will be beneficial for your child’s learning if you can give your child opportunities to count in twos, threes, fives and tens. To practise their mental arithmetic including addition and subtraction.

-Encourage your child to get involved with everyday mathematical problems, such as helping with the shopping and handling real money and weighing ingredients.
