

In English, we will continue to build on our phonics from Reception. We will develop pencil control, practise good pencil grip and start to form all letters correctly. We will begin to develop our confidence when writing and be able to translate some of our ideas into simple captions and sentences. We will also listen to and respond to a range of poems and fiction texts.

In Maths, our work will be very practical and hands on. We will be working individually, as a class and in groups. We will be learning to count, read and write numbers to 100, count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10, play number games, identify one more/less and use everyday

objects to help us solve simple maths problems and calculations.

In Science, we will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish and reptiles. We will name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. We will also be looking at which animals are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
