- \*Queen Victoria was born in London on 24th May 1819.
- \*She became queen on 20th June 1837 at the age of 18.
- \*Only children from rich families went to school.
- \*Poor children or orphans had to go to work.
- \*Boys and girls were taught separately and had certain jobs like sewing for girls and woodwork for boys.
- \*Schools had severe punishments like the cane.
- \*Living conditions were very different for example toilets were outside.
- \*Rules and routines at school were very different for example children were not allowed to eat at school and sometimes had no breaks.
- \*Charles Dickens and Charles Mackintosh are famous Victorians.
