<b>Human features</b>	Things that have been built by people for example houses, roads and bridges.	<b>Capital city</b>	A city where the government of a country is located.	<b>Australian Outback</b>	The large, remote desert wilderness of Australia. It is dry and arid, with few people, and difficult living conditions. 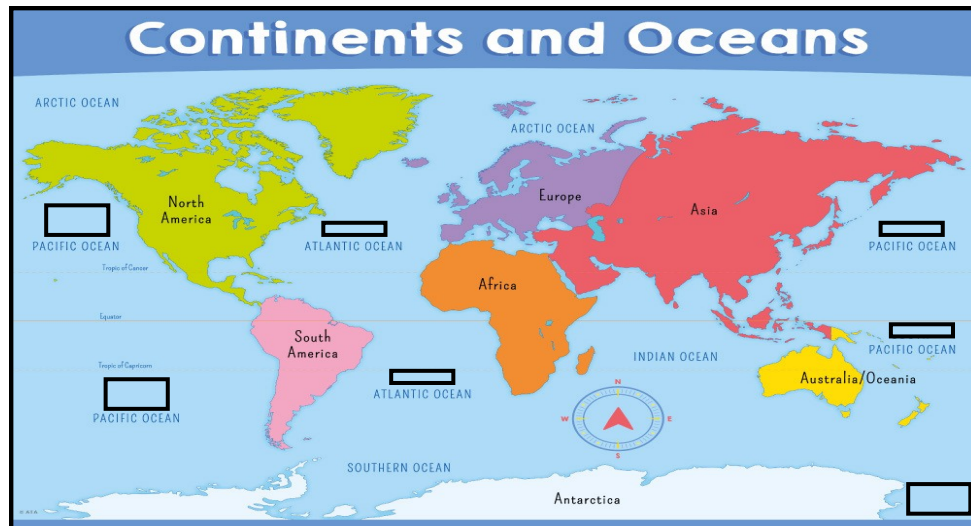
## Continents and Oceans

## The United Kingdom

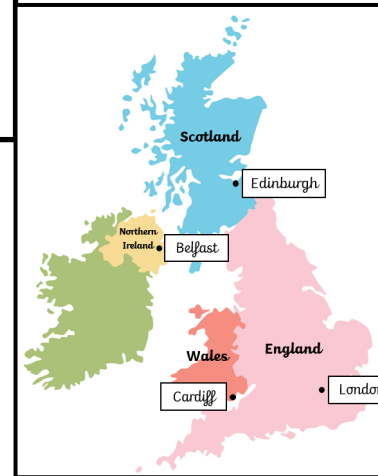
The United Kingdom is made up of four countries:
