United Kingdom	A country in Europe made up of 4 countries: England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.
Capital city	The main city where the government of a country is based
Physical features	Things that are natural that have not been made by people. For example mountains, trees, oceans and plants.
Human features	Things that have been built by people for example houses, roads and bridges.
Ocean	Large areas of salt water on Earth
Sea	Smaller areas of salt water that are located beside land.
Aerial photograph	A photograph taken from above with a camera mounted on an aircraft, balloon, rocket, kite or similar vehicle.
Fieldwork	Learning directly in the real world outside the classroom.
