Why are rainforests important to us? —Theme Content—National Curriculum links

English

Children will look at different types of poetry, linking it to their rainforest learning. Children will then write about the use of palm oil and the effect it has on the animals in the rainforest.

Maths

Children will about time using an analogue and a digital clock. They will be learning the Roman numerals to 12.

Science

Children will be learning about the different parts of a plant and their functions.

Foundation Subjects

Geography

The children will learn about the Amazon Rainforest. They will be able to identify why it is so important to us and what animals live there. We will also look at deforestation and the impact this is having on habitat and the O2 levels.
