World War II began in 1939 and ended in 1945.

Britain declared war on Germany due to the invasion of Poland.

The key allies were Britain, France and the USA and the axis were Germany, Italy and Japan.

Key cities were bombed during the Battle of Britain and the Blitz (1940-1941).

Many children were evacuated to the countryside and there were both positive and negative experiences.

The home front played a key role in the war: rationing, the women in factories, the home guard, firefighting, gas masks and bomb shelters etc.

Propaganda posters were used to gain the support of the public on both sides.
