Year 4 went back in time with history experts, History off the Page, who brought Roman Times to life.

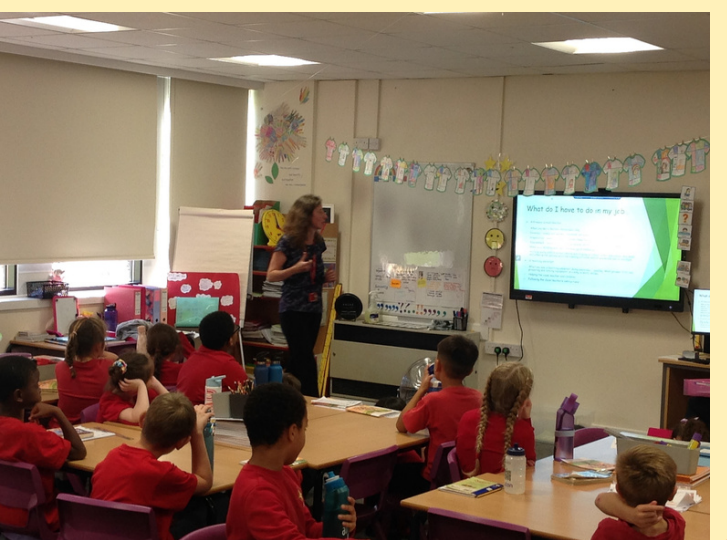
