

Attendance




- attainment in school

Absence procedures

You must leave a message by 8.30am every day your child is absent with the reason, we cannot accept just 'unwell' and you must confirm their symptoms. We have an 'under the weather' policy and encourage children to come in, as often the distraction of school & their friends will help. Please let the teacher know at drop-off so they will keep a close eye. We also have paracetamol, ibuprofen and Piriton which we can give with your permission.
