

Parent user guide for Atom Learning

Step 1 – Log in to atomlearning.com, using your child's username and password found in their reading record.

You will see the screen below. Their homework for that week will be in their To-do List. This will not appear until the Thursday it is set, and will disappear from the list once completed. This is the only section your child needs to complete.
